Agency provides the development of affordable housing for rental and homeownership, as well as offering Transitional Housing for Homeless families, Comprehensive Case Management, Individualized Housing Counseling, Self-sufficiency training, Financial Education and Housing Outreach Services. Incorporated throughout the agency's function in the community is the intervention and prevention of homelessness.

Services: Christian HELP believes that no child in Central Florida should go to bed hungry, should go without Christmas, that no family in Central Florida should be put out on the street, and that no family should have to live in the dark. Christian HELP is an ACCESS site for food stamps. They provide a food pantry, job referral, material support groups, spiritual support, ministry development, networking, and many volunteer opportunities.
